BACKGROUND

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a Honours degree from an accredited tertiary institution, specialising in Statistics, Economics, or related qualification. A Master's degree would be an added advantage. At least two years' experience in quantitative data analysis and research-writing. A valid Driver's license will be an added advantage.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Assist with development and implementation of data collection tools to gather and generate statistical data. Conduct data preparation (datasets cleaning and coding) for input into database. Assist in building the data analytics capabilities of the ESS team. Contribute towards the development and maintenance a statistical database to ensure availability of statistics for dissemination and research purposes. Assist in creating and maintaining quantitative data in an optimal manner to ensure data quality and integrity. Assist with conducting data analysis and drafting statistical reports. Provide project management support and assist with general administrative support where required.

CORE COMPETENCIES

Demonstrate willingness to learn. Good verbal and written communication skills. Excellent analytical skills, and attention to detail. Good understanding of the procedures used in gathering and reporting statistics. Ability to work with multiple datasets. Must be proficient with at least one statistical software packages, i.e., SPSS, R-Package, etc.
