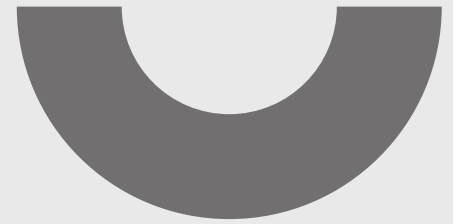

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

CORE COMPETENCIES

Analyse how effective governance is for overseeing and ensuring clean administration. Assisting with auditing of different governments departments and public institutions.
