Research assistants are required to assist the Economics and Statistical Services Unit with coordination and supervision of fieldwork data collection for various surveys projects to be conducted across KZN districts.
Minimum Requirements:	Applicants must have a minimum NQF Level 9 qualification from an accredited tertiary institution. Applicants who are in possession of qualifications in the Economics or Statistics related fields will be given preference. 06-12 months previous experience in research data collection is required. Applicants who held supervis position in the data collection will be preferred. Driver's License required (must be more than three years and able to drive).
Core competencies:	Computer Literacy. Ability to operate a mobile device. Good communication skills. Innovative and solutions oriented. Proficient in English and isiZulu. Must apply within the KZN district they reside in.
Responsibilities:	Facilitate fieldwork data collection and supervise data collectors to ensure accurate data is collected. Fieldwork deployment preparation – confirm the availability of assigned fieldworkers within designated district. Orientate data collectors on the data collection tool (questionnaire). Assist with stakeholder/key informant interviews data collection for projects.
