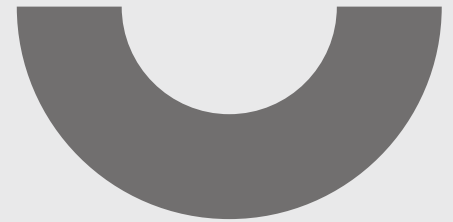

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must have a minimum (NQF Level 8) Honours in Business Studies/ Entrepreneurship/ Development Studies or a related field. A master's degree in any of these fields of study is a distinct advantage. An appreciation of the KwaZulu-Natal's social and economic discourse is beneficial.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Investigate and understand the historical and current set-up of social grants pay-out system in the province of KwaZulu-Natal. Establish the pros and cons of the current social grant pay-out system. Investigate and illustrate how social grant pay-out could be potentially more beneficial if shifted back to the old pay-out system and the feasibility of spaza shops conducting the pay-outs instead. Conduct an economic impact analysis of how the different pay-out systems impact on the economic well-being of the KZN communities. Advise the council of traditional leadership in KZN on the most suitable course of action after consideration of all relevant factors.
