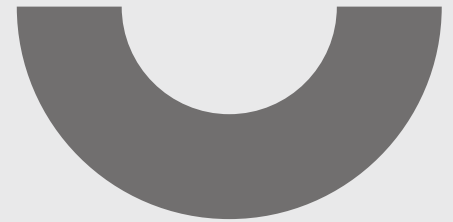

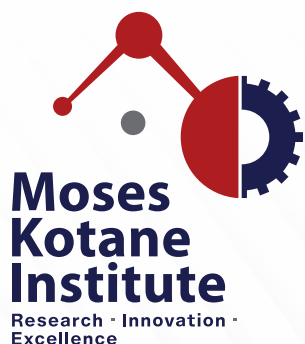

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

A suitable candidate must hold a Tertiary Qualification: (NQF 8) Honours Degree in Finance/Economics / Financial Economics/ Actuarial Science Studies or a related field. A master's degree in finance/ Economics/ Financial Economics or an MBA is a distinct advantage. Knowledge of the KwaZulu-Natal economy's sectors and its material resources.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Ascertain the Contractual and Legal Background needed to set up a Stock Exchange in KwaZulu-Natal by engaging the right expertise. Investigate the successful Stock Exchanges set up in regions with relevance for KZN and outline a few case studies. Conduct an exercise of learning from "the best in class" in terms of Stock Exchanges for lessons learnt. Gather all relevant information needed for establishing a Stock exchange in KwaZulu-Natal and determine the area most suitable for its establishment. Provide an indication of the material and human resources required to start a Stock Exchange. Propose a governance and operating structure for the KZN Stock Exchange. Present findings to relevant stakeholders/forums.
