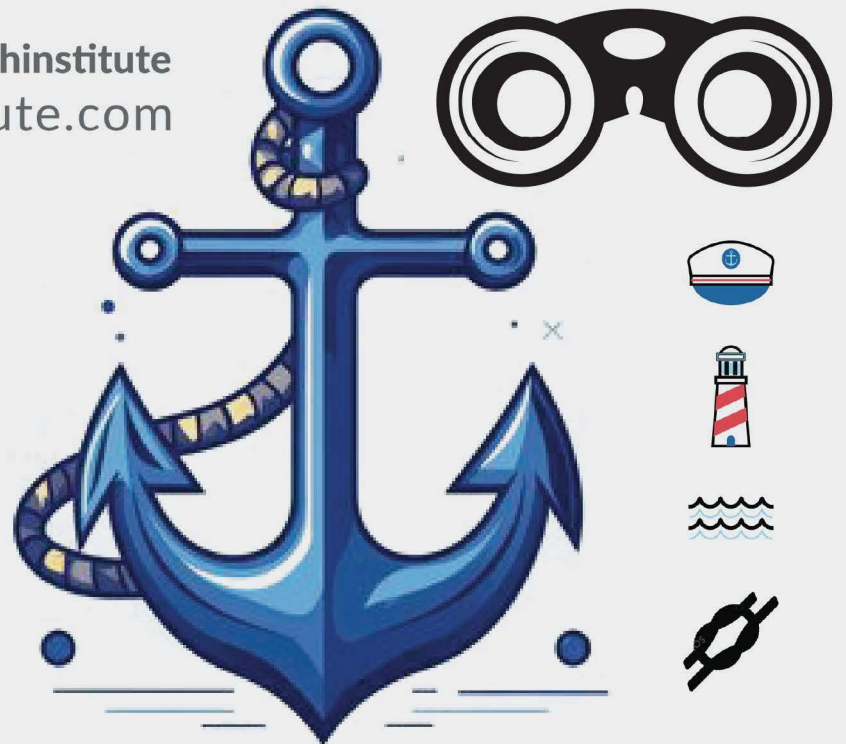

The STCW Course, accredited by SAMSA, is designed to equip Maritime professionals with essential safety, survival and emergency response skills in compliance with national and international Maritime safety standards. The Moses Kotane Research Institute (MKRI) is offering this opportunity to support unemployed individuals in KwaZulu-Natal (KZN) who aspire to build careers in the Maritime sector. This opportunity includes only tuition fee; Applicants must be prepared to cover their own accommodation and travel expenses.

### PROGRAMME DETAILS

- Course Name: STCW
- Duration: 10 days
- Number of Participants: 21
- The programme will be delivered in Durban by qualified facilitators and includes hands-on practical training, culminating with a SAMSA accredited certificate.
- The programme will be conducted in English.
- Support and general communication may be provided in IsiZulu where necessary.

### REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be South African citizens residing in KZN (preferably rural or township-based)
- Maritime related qualifications, including deck cadets, engine cadets, hospitality, lifeguard, engineering and tourism from accredited institutions

### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (Submission of the following is mandatory)

- 1) Certified copy of Identity Document
- 2) Proof of Residence
- 3) CV of Applicant

### *Applications will not be considered if:*

- The applicant does not meet the eligibility criteria.
- The application is incomplete or missing required documents.
- The application is submitted after the closing date.
- The applicant does not reside in KZN.
- The application is not sent to the designated email address
- The applicant is required to be available in Durban during the course period
