




BACKGROUND

The Skippers Licence is accredited by South African Maritime Safety Authority (SAMSA) and enables the beneficiary to skipper any vessel less than 9 metres, 15 nautical miles from shore. The Moses Kotane Research Institute (MKRI) is offering this opportunity to support unemployed individuals from Small-Scale Fishing Cooperatives and Coastal Communities in Kwa-Zulu Natal (KZN). This opportunity includes only tuition fee; Applicants must be prepared to cover their own accommodation and travel expenses.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

- Course: Skippers Licence
- Duration: 5 days
- Number of Participants: 10
- The programme will be delivered in Durban by qualified facilitators and includes hands-on practical training, culminating in recognised certification.
- The programme will be conducted in English
- Support and general communication may be provided in IsiZulu where necessary.

REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be South African citizens residing in KZN (preferably coastal rural areas)
- Grade 10
- Fishing industry experience or be familiar with Maritime industry

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (Submission of the following is mandatory)

- 1) Certified copy of Identity Document
- 2) Proof of Residence
- 3) CV of Applicant

Applications will not be considered if:

- The applicant does not meet the eligibility criteria.
- The application is incomplete or missing required documents.
- The application is submitted after the closing date.
- The applicant does not reside in KZN.
- The application is not sent to the designated email address.
